Sub: Protest against transfer order of Dr. Rezaul Karim and appeal for immediate withdrawal.

Sir,

Apropos to the subject captioned above, we express our deep concern to the facts as furnished below.

1. We to our extent of utter surprise go on observing that repeatedly the long convetional democratic norms not to transfer any state secretary or President from HQ or its vicinity, are being violated and to us its simply an attack on organisational rights. The process was set in with Dr Satyajit Chakroborty, the then General Secretary of AHSD, followed by Dr Goutam Mukherjee, President of AHSD, Dr Sajal Biswas, Secretary of SDF, and the feather added, Prof Karim of WBDF. Needless to say that the list includes a large number of our activists who have been transferred to the remote places in the last few years. As these different organizations unitedly are on movement for the cause of security of care givers in the health care institutions and for the shake of "rights" of the doctors and people at large, in a sustainable fashion, the vendetta are bestowed upon the leadership.

As the WBMC Election 2018 is in final crux and Prof. Karim is contesting on behalf of joint platform of doctors, issuing such type of order at this point of time is seems to satisfy the vindictive attitude and interest of the concerned authority and aiming to demotivate our supporters and to create panicky among the doctors community as a whole.
3. Lastly, but not the least, transferring Prof Karim to Raiganj MC, newly proposed, where there is no PG course of Radiology, can only spoil his academic excellence, consequently depriving medical students at large.

In the light of the above, we once again protest such types of motivated and vindictive orders and demand for withdrawal of these at the earliest to restore the basic democratic practices, failing which will make us compelled to go on United movement.
