Sub: Gross irregularities in dispatch of Registered envelopes containing West Bengal Medical Council Election Ballots, 2018 from Malda Head Post Office, North Bengal Region, West Bengal.

Sir,

We would like to intimate you that the Election process, scheduled to be held in every five years, for the autonomous body, West Bengal Medical Council, for the year 2018 is in full swing for which Medical Teachers of different medical colleges of West Bengal (Clause G) will receive envelopes containing the Ballot papers at the department address of the respective medical colleges.

But to our utter dismay, we have to know that till today NO BALLOT paper has been received by the Teachers cum eligible electors of Malda Medical College, in spite of reaching the same at Malda Head P.O., from Returning Officer, WBMC in time, as has been intimated by the office of WBMC with tracking details to an eligible voter of the said institution cum bonafide member of our organisation.

And upon approaching to the Malda Post Office, the on duty officer/staff intimated some of the Medical Teachers of MMC, that some representative of Indian Medical Association, Malda Branch namely Pint Das under the communicating letter from Indian Medical Association Malda (without mentioning any post of the organisation and with unverified signature) has been provided all the registered envelopes in the names of different teachers by some postman of the said post office quite unlawfully and consequently these Teachers have been deprived the right to cast their vote in this election of paramount professional interest (Enclosed herewith for your ready reference).

Under this circumstance, we express our deep anguish and concern and demand a thorough immediate enquiry from your end and enable us to get your response at the earliest. This will guide us to proceed to take due course of action under arena of law in order to uphold the preservation of democratic rights and lawful functioning of govt. body.
